



PROGRAM BRIEF

This MARC Leaders Workshop is a unique Catalyst program that enables directors through senior executives to sharpen awareness of inequality, develop critical inclusive leadership strategies, and hone skills to make a lasting impact. In this 1.5 day workshop, participants will engage with a cross-company network to enhance their own leadership effectiveness and discuss ways to effect change in their respective organizations. Participants will:

- Examine the factors that both limit and drive men's participation.
- Explore gender stereotypes, mutual benefits of equality, and strategies for establishing effective partnerships between men and women.
- Discuss workplace culture and the experience of insider/outsider status.
- Uncover unconscious bias, privilege, and opportunities and skills for leaders to drive change.
