

# CATALYST AWARD *Nomination*

## ELIGIBILITY WORKSHEET

This worksheet includes key context and questions to help you determine whether your organization's initiative is eligible for nomination for the [Catalyst Award](#). Please visit the [Catalyst Award Application](#) page for more information.

### CONTEXT

First, it is important to identify the scope and target population of your initiative.

**1. Define the geography for the initiative you would like to nominate:**

## ELIGIBILITY PREREQUISITES

Answer questions 1–10 to determine whether your organization’s initiative is eligible for nomination in the current Catalyst Award cycle.
